

City of Markesan Recycling & Trash Guidelines

PLEASE SAVE FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

GENERAL INFO

- Trash & recycling should be placed at the curb by 7:00am on Fridays.
- Per City ordinance, items should NOT be placed at the curb prior to 7:00pm the night before.
- Please make note of changes due to holidays or inclement weather – in holiday weeks, or when pickup is unable to be made due to inclement weather, regularly scheduled pickup will happen the following day (Saturday??). This means if a holiday or bad storm happens on a Monday, our Friday pickup will change to Saturday.

TRASH

- All trash must be in clear or white, see-through plastic bags no larger than 33 gallons, with a maximum weight of 50 pounds per bag. Please, NO BLACK bags.
- Bundled trash no more than 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length will also be picked up. Make sure bundles are tied securely. Bundles should also have a maximum weight of 50 pounds.
- PLEASE NOTE - the following items will not be collected curbside:
 - ❖ Contact Waste Management (ph?), or a disposal company of your choice, to discuss options for these materials (a fee will be charged):
 - ✓ Tires, batteries, oil, and hazardous wastes
 - ✓ Construction debris
 - ✓ Cement
 - ❖ These materials may be taken to the Recycling Center on County Road A (a small fee may be charged):
 - ✓ Electronic items (e-waste), such as computers, TV's, cell phones, etc.
 - ✓ Furniture, appliances, or microwaves, and Freon appliances
 - ✓ Any items weighing more than 50 pounds
 - ✓ Brush and compostable materials
- Twice a year, bulky items such as furniture, mattresses, carpet, storm windows & doors, will be picked up curbside. Watch the City newsletter for dates (once in spring and fall).



RECYCLING

- All recyclables must be in clear or blue plastic bags no larger than 33 gallons.
- All recyclables may be mixed together, including glass, plastics (#1-7), aluminum, tin cans, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, and cardboard
- Please rinse all containers and discard lids in the regular trash
- Loose cardboard should not be placed at the curb. If cardboard will not fit in a plastic bag, it should be broken down and tied securely in a bundle.
- Please see back side of this sheet for additional guidance on the types of materials that must be recycled.
