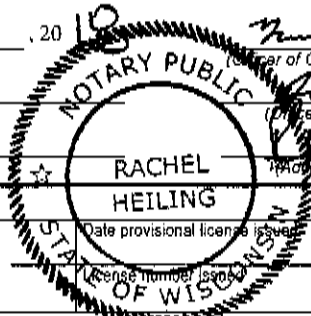

ORDINANCE NO. 240

An Ordinance amending various sections of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan.

The Common Council of the City of Markesan in session duly begun on the 26th day of April, 2018, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 136-1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Markesan Memorial Cemetery shall be managed by the Cemetery Sexton in accordance with policies established by the Public Property and Health Committee and approved by the Common Council. All burials and headstone/marker placement must be approved and inspected by the Cemetery Sexton.

SECTION 2: Section 136-2 G of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan is hereby amended to read as follows:

G. There shall be only one burial or body per grave space, except that two burials or bodies per grave space shall be allowed if the remains are cremated or are infants younger than 12 months. Each burial space shall have a concrete vault with at least 20 inches of ground cover.

SECTION 3: Section 136-2 L of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan is hereby created to read as follows:

L. The digging of any grave shall only be performed by a person/company that has been approved by the Public property committee. The list of currently approved grave diggers is available from the Markesan City Clerk's office. The grave digger shall be paid directly by the funeral director/mortuary. Collection of the fee shall be the responsibility of the grave digger.

SECTION 4: Section 200-10 C (3) of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan is hereby created to read as follows:

(3) The Clerk-Treasurer, upon the recommendation of both the Police Chief and Mayor, may issue a Picnic license to an organization who has applied for a Temporary Class "B" Picnic license.

SECTION 5: Section 252-3 H of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan is hereby amended to read as follows:

H. Noxious weeds. All noxious weeds, as defined in 66.0407(1), Wis. Stats. In addition, other rank growth of vegetation, and all weeds, grasses and plants over 6 inches in height, excluding trees and shrubs, which:

SECTION 6: Sections 252-8 C and 252-8 D of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan are hereby amended to read as follows:

C. Enforcement. If a property owner fails to control the growth of such weeds or rank growth of vegetation on his property, the Weed Commissioner shall serve upon him

notice of once per calendar year as to this fact. If such owner fails to abate this nuisance within five days after service of the notice, the Commissioner shall take action to abate such public nuisance.

D. Costs. If the City causes a nuisance to be removed as provided in Subsection C above, the actual cost thereof, together with an administrative fee equal to 10% of the actual cost, shall be charged to the property owner. Any damage to city equipment will also be charged to the property owner. If such charges are not paid by November 1 of the year in which they are billed, such charges, together with an additional administrative fee for collection equal to 10% of the total such charges and fees, shall be extended on the next succeeding tax roll as a tax charged against the property affected and collected in the same manner as are other taxes, pursuant to 66.0517, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication
