**New Business:**

- Discussion and Action on Waste and Recycling Bids: Proposal was put out and two bids were received. After discussion, the Committee would like additional information:
  - History on bulky trash totals against total households for the last 3 – 5 years
  - Comparison of Markesan bulky trash totals against similar municipalities
  - Updated spreadsheet with bulky trash drop site vs. curbside (2X year)
  - Waste Management will provide information on cost per month if the contract is not renewed before contract expiration dateThe City Attorney will be asked to attend the Council meeting regarding the bidding process.
- Discussion and Action on Park Service Organizations Agreement: No action. Tentative dates for a meeting have been proposed.
- Discussion and Action on Draft TID #1, 2017 Annual Report: Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Thiem to approve the draft 2017 Annual Report. Motion carried.
- Discussion and Action on Feeding of Wild Animals: The Chief will work with the DNR to put an article in the paper regarding the problems with feeding wild animals and the fines and problems associated with touching and moving wild animals.
