New Business:

Discussion and Action on the Garbage Collection Ordinance: Due to the changes with the garbage collection contract, some changes are needed to the ordinance regarding disposal and storage of waste and refuse. The changes involve the information about the containers. Also, the draft clarifies how commercial properties are handled bringing the ordinance verbiage in line with current practices. Discussion and Action on Current Lawn Bill for the Markesan Lions: Motion by Mayor Abendroth/Ald. Thiem that the City Clerk send a letter to the Lions asking about the status of the 2016 and 2017 lawnmowing bills. Motion carried.

Discussion and action on 4, 14, and 24 South Bridge Street Properties: Motion by Ald. Triemstra/Mayor Slate that all three property owners that the City Clerk contact each property owner via letter asking for a status update to be provided to the Public Property Committee by October 1, 2018. Motion carried.

Discussion and Action on responsibility of Soldiers and Sailors Beach - Little Green Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District: Harlan Barkley, Chairman LGLPRD, addressed the Committee regarding the swimming beach at Soldiers and Sailors Park and the blue-green algae which presents health issues to humans and pets.
