

A grant has been submitted for a replacement vehicle to be delivered in the summer of 2019 and will cover 80% of the cost of the vehicle estimated to be \$36,000.

The remaining cost (20%) of \$7200 must come from the municipalities we serve. The following is a pro-rated amount according to population. The amount due is decreased by a surplus in 2015 of 742.40 bringing the total needed to \$6457.60. **We kindly ask that your share be placed in your 2019 budget for payment to us by June 1st, 2019.**
