MINUTES

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order by Mayor Slate at 6:30 pm.
2. **Roll Call:** Present were Clerk-Treasurer Betsy Amend, Ald. Abendroth, Ald. Bieszki, Ald. Henke, Mayor Slate, Ald. Kazda, Ald. Thiem, and Ald. Triemstra. Also present were Will Pflum, Scott Mundro, Berlin Journal, and Phil Watry.
3. **Citizen's Comments:** Scott Mundro spoke on behave the Green Lake County Economic Development Council and informed that the council it is at the beginning stages of developing a County-Wide Assessment Housing Survey. They may be reaching out to municipalities in future. Ald. Kazda invited the Council to Lucy Hazelwood's retirement open house on Saturday, March 23rd.
4. **Discussion and Action on Hiring Phil Watry to Fill the Full-Time Patrol Position:** Motion Ald. Bieszki/Ald. Triemstra to hire Phil Watry as the Full-Time Patrol Officer at \$22.21 an hour and two weeks' vacation; motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote.
5. **Discussion and Action on Pre-Employment Agreement (Conditional Offer):** Motion Ald. Thiem/Ald. Henke to accept the Conditional Offer for Phil Watry which limits training (due to pre-employment history with the City) and starts Watry at \$22.21 an hour and gives him two weeks of vacation; motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote.
6. **Discussion and Action on Full-Time Contract:** Motion Ald. Bieszki/Ald. Abendroth to waive the Full-Time Contract (Three Year Contract) because Watry fulfilled the contract when he worked for the City in 2015-2018; motion carried 6-0 on a roll call vote.
7. **Adjournment:** Motion Ald. Triemstra /Ald. Abendroth to adjourn; motion carried 6-0. The meeting adjourned at 6:43 pm.
