Public Works Report:

Discussion and Action on 650 North Margaret Street Raze Bids: Mayor Slate excused himself from the discussion. Martin advised the committee that the low bid was from Pollesch Construction with a bid of \$3235. No further action taken. The City Clerk will check with the City Attorney on the status of the Raze order.

Old Business:

Discussion and Action on Maintenance of "Memorial Trees" on Hwy 44: The City Attorney advised the Committee that the property owners are responsible for maintenance of the trees and the City has control of the right-of-way. If the property owner does not maintain the trees, the City can do maintenance or removal and place the cost on the tax roll if it chooses. The Mayor asked that this item be tabled until the July meeting when the Lions Club officials plan to attend the meeting.

New Business:

Discussion and Action on Long Lawn Notices: Police Chief Pflum advised the Committee that the notices went out to sixteen properties last week and a couple people complained about the notices. The Committee discussed the ordinance and actions taken and fully supports all actions taken to ensure the City policies and procedures are followed. As always, the Committee encourages any citizen with concerns to come to the Committee meeting and asks that, if approached with concerns, all City employees and Officials encourage that person to bring their concerns to the Committee.

Discussion and Action on Beach Preservation: The Mayor contacted the County regarding this issue and the County will be following up with Martin with ideas on a plan to: (1) look at the erosion coming from the top of the hill and (2) look at sand containment on the beach. Once a plan is determined, the City will look at grant opportunities.
