
The Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA) Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR) received the City of Markesan's application for the 2020 Community Development Block Grant for Public Facilities (CDBG-PF) program, requesting financial assistance for a North End Street and Utilities Infrastructure Improvements project.

To be considered for a 2020 CDBG-PF award, the unit of general local government (UGLG) must have given adequate notice of the pre-application public hearing, in accordance with the City's CDBG Citizen Participation Plan. DEHCR's review of the City's application revealed that the City did not provide a full 2-weeks (14-days) notice as required. As stated in the 2020 CDBG-PF Application Instructions and in the Citizen Participation Application Attachments section of the CDBG-PF Application, failure to comply with the citizen participation requirements may disqualify the application. The CDBG-PF application process is highly competitive and the City's application was disqualified from consideration. Unfortunately, the Division cannot assist in the financing of the City's project.

An applicant that objects to the denial of an award has the right to appeal the decision. A formal appeals process is available for applicants that believe that a non-funding decision has been made in error. The notice of appeal must include the name of the applicant, title of the project and a short summary of why the applicant is appealing the decision, including identifying the error(s) the City believes DEHCR made in reviewing the City's CDBG-PF Application. The notice must be filed with the DEHCR Bureau of Community Development Director within thirty (30) days from the date of this decision letter.
