The hearing was called to Order at 7:18 PM.

Roll Call by Sign in Sheet.

The City Council of the City of Markesan conducted a public hearing regarding its proposed application for Community Development Block Grant Public Facilities (CDBG-PF) Program funds. The public was invited to attend to learn about the CDBG program, to help identify additional community development needs, and to comment on the activities proposed to be included in the CDBG application.

Items Discussed are listed below:

1. Identification of total potential funds
2. Eligible CDBG activities
3. Presentation of identified community development needs
4. Identification of any community development needs by public
5. Presentation of activities proposed for CDBG application, including potential residential displacement.
6. Citizen input regarding proposed and other CDBG activities

In summary, Elizabeth Foellmi, from General Engineering Company, presented that the project is estimated to be around \$2 million dollars. If funding is granted, hoping to have the cost for the City be half of that. The project is for water main and laterals to curb stops on Catherine, Edmaz, N. High, Bridge St, N. Main and St. Joseph Streets. Mostly water and street work to be completed. Some sewer work will be done on N. Main Street. There will be no residential displacement with minimal or no cost to the homeowners. Should hear by mid-July if funding has been granted to the City. The project is to start in spring of 2022.
