Public Works Report:

Discussion and Action on Allowing Colleen Guderski to Collect Cans at Recycling Center for Non-Profit Group Called Wisconsin Right to Life, Green Lake County Chapter: Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Kazda to contact the other towns involved with the recycling center and get their views on allowing non-profits to use the recycling center to place a receptacle to collect cans. Motion Carried.

New Business:

Discussion and Action on Quote from Waltom Memorials to Replace Damaged Scroll Marker in Cemetery in Amount of \$475.00: Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Tetzlaff to pay Waltom Memorials \$475 out of the cemetery budget for the damaged scroll marker. Motion Carried.

Discussion and Action on Cemetery Mapping with Money from American Rescue Plan Act – Total Allocation is \$146,640.65; Received \$73,320.32 in 2021 and the remainder in 2022. Also using this money for Utility Project in 2022: Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Kazda to move this item to council for discussion. Motion carried.

Discussion and Action on Maintenance and Replacement of the Coolers in the Big Building at Soldier's & Sailor's Park: Dan Prill from the Lions purchased three reconditioned coolers with the cost shared between the City and the Lions. The coolers will be placed in the kitchen, bar, and scout cabin at the park. Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Triemstra to have Joe Strelow look into selling the old coolers that still work and take the nonfunctioning coolers to the recycling center. Motion carried.

Discussion and Action on Maintenance and Replacement of the Beach Buoys at Soldier's & Sailor's Park: New buoys have been ordered, and they will be put in place once they arrive.

Discussion and Action on the Purchase of the Storage Building behind the Library: No action.

Discussion and Action on Zoning Map Updates: Ald. Prill requested that the online zoning maps be updated to correct any zoning inconsistencies for properties in the City. Motion by Mayor Slate/Ald. Triemstra to move this project to the Streets, Buildings & Utilities Committee and to have Ald. Prill work on the project with the City. Motion carried.

Discussion and Action on Donation of Three Trees to the City: Motion by Mayor Slate/ Ald. Kazda to accept the donation of the three trees and have Joe Strelow determine a good place to plant them. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Discussion and Action on 650 N. Margaret Street Property Update: An emailed update from Connie Wilsnack regarding the latest actions taken on the property was reviewed. Motion by Ald. Triemstra/Ald.
