In an effort to reduce snowplowing overtime things will be made safe and passable on weekends then a more detailed cleanup will be done the following week when we are not on overtime, same with during the week. Below is a list of projects to get done in the first quarter.

- 3-Get the warming shack cleaned and sanitized
- 4-Rent a carpet cleaner and do the carpets in the office area in city hall
- 5-Haul Snow out of city lot
- 6-Rust mitigation of the payloader
