Discussion & Action to Community Response from Spruce Up Letter & Brochure - Some response was noted as a result of the letter and brochure that recently went out to all residents.. Most questions concerned the upcoming County Wide Clean Sweep Day. We will include this information on the City's Facebook page, along with including it in the next water/sewer bills.

List of Volunteers – Committee is continuing to formulate a list of volunteers who would be willing to help with projects in the City. These volunteers have already assisted some residents. Other areas where these volunteers could help were discussed.

Concerns Relating to Specific Areas of the Municipal Code - Copies of our existing Municipal Code relating to the three areas of concern (recreational storage, use of front setback area, and long term parking on streets) will be provided for our next meeting. Discussion will be held as to whether all our concerns are already addressed in the Code or if we will propose that changes be considered.

Specific Areas of Concern Within City – Several areas of concern have already been addressed and the issues corrected. Other areas will be addressed at our next meeting.

Ways to Encourage Cleanup/Spruce up in the City – Several additional suggestions were made but no action was made to proceed.
