

## KEEP MARKESAN GRAND COMMITTEE

The **Keep Markesan Grand Committee** meeting was called to order by Chairman Will Pflum on July 26, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at City Hall. Members in attendance were Chairman Pflum, Betsy Amend, Rachel Heiling and Pat Prill.

Discussion & Action on 325 E John Street Property - Following a complaint that was received by the City, the Building Inspector, Tim Tripp, inspected the exterior of the property. His report indicated minor structural issues in addition to property maintenance concerns. Discussion was held as to what the Committee's next step should be. It was decided we will inquire of the Streets & Building Committee how to proceed. We have identified several properties within the City that are in violation of the Property Maintenance Ordinance and will be asking the Committee for permission to refer these properties to the Building Inspector to inspection.

Concerns Relating to Specific Areas of the Municipal Code - Copies of our existing Municipal Code relating to the three areas of concern (recreational storage, use of front setback area, and long term parking on streets) were provided. Discussion was held as to whether all our concerns are already addressed in the Code. We will continue to monitor these areas of concern.

Specific Areas of Concern Within City – A list of 21 areas of concern were reviewed ranging from front setback violations, to unlicensed/abandoned vehicles, to weed and brush issues. Letters will be sent to property owners to correct most of the issues. Other areas will be addressed at our next meeting.

As there was no further business to come before the Committee, motion was made by Pat/Rachel to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 11:02 a.m.
