## **Dodge Charger Final Settlement**

EMC Insurance has issued payment to the City of Markesan for the total loss of the 2019 Dodge Charger. The market value replacement settlement they gave for the Dodge Charger was \$26,882.50.

Then they paid \$14,966.51 to up fit and get graphics on the replacement vehicle which will be the Dodge Durango. They also paid \$1,615 for the decommission of the Dodge Charger which is having it completely cleaned out of all of our equipment and the decals removed.

Total check amount that was cut to the City of Markesan from EMC was \$42,964.01 and a \$500 check will be cut to the City of Markesan from Green Lake County to cover the \$500 deductible amount.

To help with comparison this department purchased the 2019 Dodge Charger in the spring of 2019 and paid \$25,932.00.

### **Golf Cart Ordinance Modification**

This department is requesting the committee to review a possible change to Golf Cart Ordinance 355-64.1. This department would like to modify section F-12.

Currently the ordinance reads in section F-12:

**Golf carts shall only be operated on City streets which have a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less.**

This department is proposing the change that F-12 would read:

*Golf carts shall only be operated on City streets which have a posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less.*

The reason for this proposal is that numerous things have been developed and built up just outside of the 25 mph speed zone that many community members utilize. Examples include the Post Office, Bank, Pharmacy, etc. This department feels that golf carts could safely travel to these locations as long as all other rules are closely adhered to.

We have had golf carts in Markesan for numerous years now and have had very little issue with them with the majority of all golf cart operators being respectful of all rules and regulations.

This department did contact City Attorney Dan Sondalle and he did draft the official amendment. That amendment is attached.

### **Update on Charger**

The insurance has deemed the Dodge Charger a total loss. They are working with this department closing to cover the up-fitting and decaling of a replacement squad which will be the Dodge Durango.

At this time we will keep the Ford SUV and decide later this year on how to proceed early next year with replacing that vehicle now that the Dodge Charger has been replaced.

Final numbers from the insurance aren't in yet but I will provide all those numbers to the committee/council once this department has those numbers.

## Markesan Public Library Report – June 2023

### Programming:

We had our Kick Off Party on Monday, June 5th from 11:00 am – 1:00 pm. Police Chief Will Pflum started the party with a special storytime that the kids enjoyed. Then, kids and families could see the prizes on display upstairs, spin the prize wheel and get their reading raffle tickets. We had lawn games, provided by WCTS (Winnefox Cooperative Technical Services), as well as snacks and drinks. We also had blank canvases and markers that kids could color. We gave them the option to let us display them in the library for the month, and some of them left their artwork for the display. 2 teens and 2 other National Honor Society members were here as volunteers to help run the snacks, canvas art station, and lawn games. Total attendance was 21 kids and 7 adults.

This month, our staff (Karen and Val) will lead two Storytimes, a morning and an afternoon one. Karen Jensen also is leading weekly storytime groups for summer school groups and the Young Stars Daycare. She worked very hard to get out information and coordinate with the teachers for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> grades before the end of the school year. We're hoping this will lead to an increase in library visits and a much-needed boost to our circulation. Karen led a Pete the Cat Storytime on Wednesday, June 7th that had 21 children in attendance!

Over 60 children have signed up for the Summer Reading Program as of writing this report!

Dinosaur Dimensions will be here on Tuesday, June 20th at 6:00 pm with dinosaur puppets. I'll be here for the program and to close up the library. Kids will get to make friendship bracelets on Thursday, June 29th at 4:30 pm. The Book Club will meet on Wednesday, June 28th at 6:00 pm to talk about "Me Before You" by Jojo Moyes.

### Other Summer Reading News:

We have received generous donations this month from the Grand Marsh Turkey Club, LeRoy Meat Market, the Berlin Journal, Slate Law Office, Horicon Bank, and the Two Sisters' Piggly Wiggly. We are hoping to receive other positive responses to our donation letters, but are very appreciative of the donations given by local businesses!

Hello Markesan Council,

First off, I want to apologize for the confusion about our playground proposal at last week's meeting. I am hoping to clarify things in this write up. Young Stars Childcare is looking to add some playground equipment to our playground. We are in the very early planning stages but would like to get approval for what we are thinking before we invest further time into planning. You will notice the attached proposal from last week's agenda.

The equipment we would be adding will not be permanent like the equipment at local parks, but it will be much larger and heavier than what we currently have. It will not be movable for lawn mowing purposes like the current pieces we have on the playground now.

The larger preschool playground equipment pictured on page 3 of the proposal will require us to have a roughly 31 foot by 30-foot rectangle of 9 inches of ground surfacing. Our first preference would be to use wood chips if approved by the council. What we would do is construct the equipment, place it in the center of the rectangle and then fill it with 9 inches of wood chips. The equipment would not need to be dug in as it is heavy enough. To enclose the wood chips, we would use treated lumber to make the rectangle. The size and amount of wood chips is a requirement for safety from Department of Children and Families (our licensing agency).

The infant toddler equipment pictured on page 5 is just a large plastic play structure that would sit on the grass. It would not need to be dug in or have any surfacing around it, however it is heavy so would not be able to be moved easily. Mowing would need to be done around it.

All of the construction and installation would be done by Young Stars Childcare. Everything would be provided by us as well, including the ground surface material. If we were to ever discontinue our lease, we would remove the equipment, and replant grass where the equipment sat.

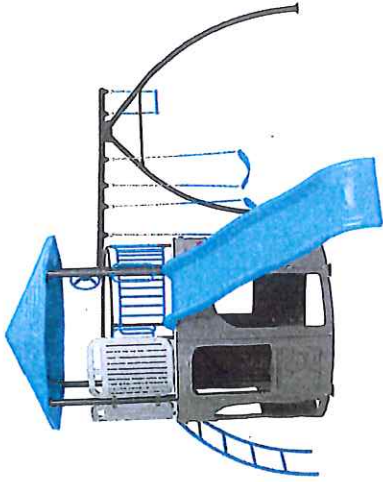

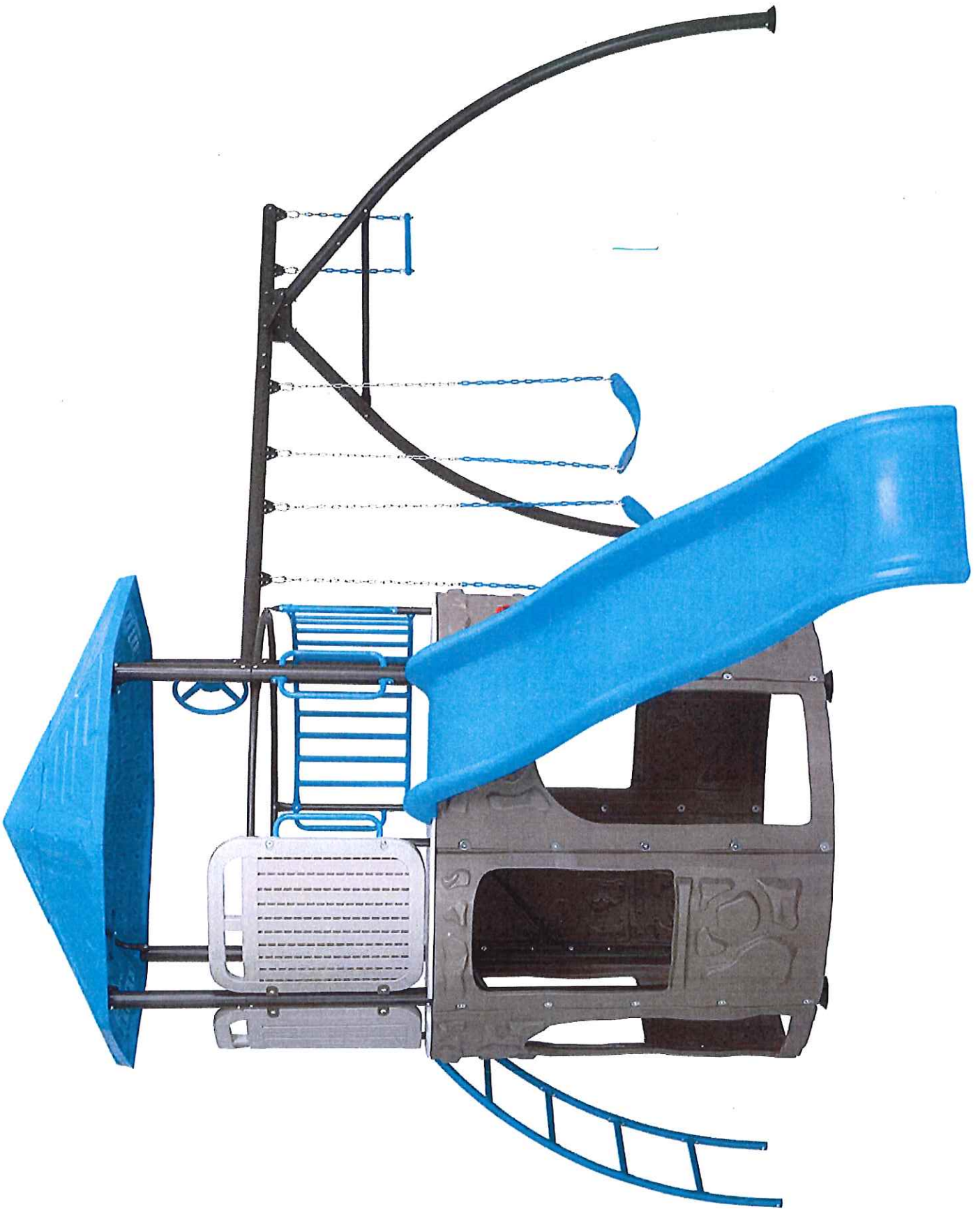

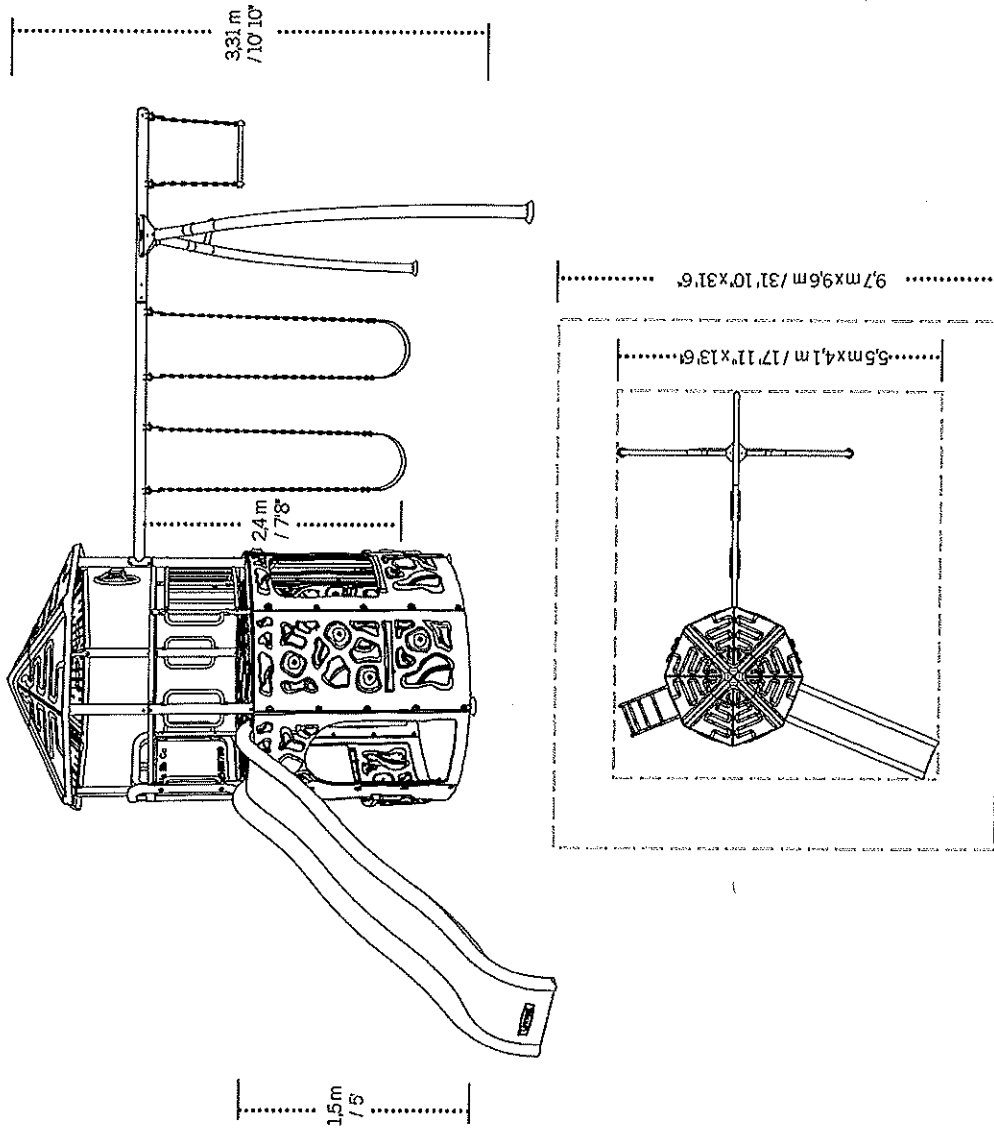

We initially filed a sign permit with the City, but discovered under ordinance 400-116 (C)(7)(B), that no permit shall be required for the following types and classes of signs: "Government signs for regulatory purposes, danger signs, and aids to service of safety which are erected by or on the order of a public officer in the performance of his public duty."

As the duly appointed Fire Chief for the Grand River Fire District, I now order replacing the fire danger sign at 877 N. Margaret Street in Markesan, Wisconsin. Please get in touch with me with any other questions.

Please provide the following information to the Mayor and the appropriate committees.

The Markesan Fire Department has applied to replace the Smokey the Bear Fire Danger Sign with a new LED sign and memorial plaque. (See attached description of what they are proposing and the photos of the existing sign) This sign is a legally non-conforming sign.

Lukasz and I reviewed the sign ordinances and cannot permit this sign based on 2 ordinances.

400-115 B (5) states:

No sign shall be erected at any location where it may, by reason of its position, shape, color or other characteristics, interfere with, obstruct the view of or be confused with any authorized traffic sign, traffic signal or other traffic device nor shall any sign make use of the words "STOP," "LOOK," "DRIVE-IN," "DANGER," "ENTER," "EXIT," "OPEN" or use any other word, phrase or symbol or character in such a manner as to interfere with, mislead or confuse traffic. "ENTER," "EXIT" and "DRIVE-IN" signs may be allowed by permit of the Common Council for use where such signs significantly aid the flow of traffic and provided further that the business for which said signs are requested shall have separate entrance and exit drives with curb cuts for each separated by a minimum distance of 10 feet.

However, due to the nature and purpose of the sign, we recommend this not hold up permitting the sign.

400-116 A (1) (a&b) states:

(1) Spacing.

(a) One freestanding sign shall be permitted for each full 200 feet of frontage on any highway, road or street which is open to the public and abutting said business premises; provided, however, that any business premises with less than 200 feet of total frontage shall be permitted one on-premises freestanding sign, and provided further that no segment of frontage along a single highway, road or street shall have more signs directed or oriented to or toward that segment than would be permitted based upon the number of feet of frontage in that segment. Signs placed pursuant to the terms of this subsection shall be removed prior to any sale, lease, assignment or transfer of property which would result in such signs failing to comply with the spacing requirements of this section. For purposes of this subsection, shopping centers and amusement parks shall be considered a single business premises.

(b) Notwithstanding all other provisions stated herein, no freestanding sign shall be placed within 100 feet of any other freestanding sign.

The Fire Department has approximately 350 feet of frontage. This ordinance allows for only 1 sign, which exists closer to the building.

I have discussed the situation with Joel Strahota, the Fire Chief. Lukasz and I support what the Fire Department is trying to do. However, we cannot approve the sign application due to the requirements outlined in 400-116 A (1) (a). We also feel that we must rule consistently in harmony with past decisions on sign applications to maintain uniformity. We recommend either the Fire Department revise their application to meet the ordinance requirements or the appropriate individuals from the City discuss with them a request for variance or other options available to them to appeal the decision.

If there is anything more we can do to assist, let us know.

## Chapter 355. Vehicles and Traffic


### Article XIV. Low-Speed Vehicles

#### § 355-64.1. Golf carts.

[Added 8-14-2018 by Ord. No. 243]

- A. Purpose. The purpose of this section is to establish routes and operation of golf carts within the City limits.
- B. Definition. "Golf cart" is defined as a motorized vehicle with four wheels which is not designed to be operated at a speed of more than 25 miles per hour. Said golf cart is generally designed to carry two to four persons, including the driver.
- C. Standard equipment regulations. Each golf cart shall be equipped with the following before operating on any City street: brakes, headlights, taillights, rear view mirror, "slow moving vehicle" sign, and a safety flag on a staff holder to put such flag at least eight feet above the road surface.
- D. Proof of liability insurance. As part of the permit process, the owner of the golf cart must provide a certificate of insurance listing the company, policy term, and minimum limits of liability of \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per accident and \$5,000 medical before a permit will be issued.
- E. The operation of golf carts is not subject to the provisions of this chapter under the following circumstances:
  - (1) The operation of the golf cart on private property, with the consent of the owner; or
  - (2) The use of a golf cart in connection with a parade, a festival or other special event, provided the consent of the sponsor is obtained and provided such vehicle is only used during such event.
- F. Operational regulations. Each operator of a golf cart shall comply with the following:
  - (1) Each operator of a golf cart must be at least 16 years old and have a valid driver's license. For the purposes of this section, an instructional permit shall not be considered as a valid driver's license nor shall any license that has been revoked, temporary or otherwise, or suspended for any reason, be considered as a valid driver's license during the period of suspension or revocation.
  - (2) Operator shall display the City of Markesan sticker prominently on the left front fender.
  - (3) All riders must remain seated when the golf cart is in motion.
  - (4) The seating capacity shall be no more than the cart was designated for but in no case shall be more than two front and two rear passengers. The operator and/or passenger shall not be permitted to stand while the golf cart is in operation.
  - (5) Golf carts may be operated on City streets between April 1 and November 1 of each calendar year and between sunrise and sunset.



- (6) Golf carts may not be operated on City streets during inclement weather such as rain, snow, fog, or when visibility may be 500 feet or less.
- (7) No golf cart shall exceed the posted speed limit.
- (8) Golf carts shall operate in single file on the far right side of the roadway.
- (9) No item can be towed by a golf cart.
- (10) No operator/person shall leave or allow any golf cart owned or operated by him/her to remain unattended on any public street, highway or public property while the motor is running or with the starting key left in the ignition.
- (11) Each golf cart shall be operated in compliance with the City motor vehicle ordinances and/or Wisconsin motor vehicle statutes.
- (12) Golf carts shall only be operated on City streets which have a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less.
- (13) The operator of a golf cart shall yield the right away to overtaking motor vehicles.
- (14) Golf carts shall not be operated on any sidewalk, pedestrian walkway, jogging path, greenway, park, and trails except for official police business or by City personnel while on City business.
- (15) Golf carts may only be parked in the same manner and at the same places designated for the parking of motor vehicles. The stopping, standing or parking of golf carts in the area where parking is not allowed or in any place that impedes the flow of traffic, pedestrian walkways or a passageway is prohibited.
-  (16) Golf carts shall not be operated on any roadway or vehicle path within the cemeteries within the City except for official use by city personnel.
- (17) Golf cart operators must use proper hand signals when turning if the golf cart is not equipped with turn signals.

#### G. Permits.

- (1) The permit, notwithstanding the date of purchase, shall be valid only from April 1 to November 1 during the calendar year of purchase. The permit will cost \$50 for the first year of registration and \$25 for subsequent yearly registration.
- (2) Unless previously revoked within a one-year period, permits may be issued by the City Clerk to owners upon:
  - (a) Completion of an application form.
  - (b) Payment of a permit fee set by the Common Council.
  - (c) Proof of a valid driver's license.
  - (d) Proof of insurance.
- (3) Owners may request a permit by mail upon submitting a completed application form, certificate of insurance, proof of a valid driver's license, and a permit fee to the City of Markesan.
- (4) Golf carts must be inspected by the Chief of Police prior to the issuance of a permit.

#### H. Violations and penalties. Violation of this section is punishable by any of the following:

- (1) Loss of operator's permit for one year.
- (2) As provided in § 1-3 of this Code.
- (3) As provided in Wisconsin Statutes.

**ORDINANCE NO. 271**

An Ordinance amending Section 355-64.1 F (12) of the Municipal Code of the City of Markesan.

The Common Council of the City of Markesan in session duly begun on the 13th day of June, 2023, hereby amends Section 355-64.1 F (12) of the City of Markesan Municipal Code to read as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 355.64.1 F (12) of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (12) Golf carts shall only be operated on City Streets which have a posted speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
