Orange Plow/salt has a cracked frame that was discovered while the leaky brake lines were being replaced. D&E suggested that we start looking for a new truck. The description of the frame is on the invoice from D&E. I spoke with DPW in Green Lake and he informed me that a new truck takes about 2 years to get. They have purchased used trucks from Quality Truck in Oshkosh, or any dealer in the valley is also a good bet.

City shop paint job completed on Saturday July 13th

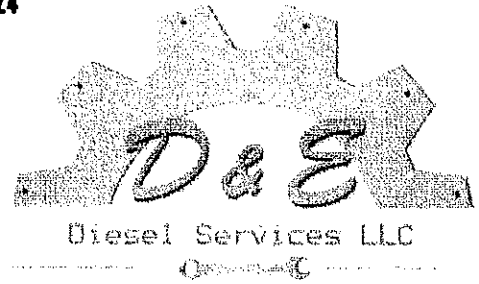
Removed the Kiwanis warming shelter ramp so a new one can be installed
