MINUTES

Call to Order at 6:00 p.m.

Roll Call by Sign-in – Pat, Joseph, Rich. Also in attendance were several interested persons.

Pat advised that 2 items on the agenda should have been put on the Streets, Building & Utilities Committee agenda – Quote for Pay Loader Engine Tune-up and Quote for Tires – 1 Ton.

Citizen's Comments – Lisa Broder, representing Markesan Chamber of Commerce, informed the Committee that the Chamber would like to work with the City to improve Kiwanis Park and are interested in any plans we have. Tami Schattschneider, representing Little Green Lake Protection & Rehabilitation District urged the Committee to support an ordinance prohibiting Wake Surfing on Little Green Lake. They are citing shoreline erosion, aquatic disruption, introduction of invasive species, and safety concerns.

Clint arrived at 6:06 p.m.

Public Works Report – A written report was submitted. Motion was made by Rich/Joseph to accept the report as presented. Motion carried.

Quote from TLB for Wood Chipping at Recycling Center – Motion was made by Rich/Pat to accept the bid from TLB in the amount of \$3,900 for wood chipping at the recycling center. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Pat/Clint to refer the Quote from Ballweg Implement Co. for Pay Loader Engine Tune Up, and the Quotes for New Tires for the 1 Ton to Council for action. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Markesan Deer Management Program Update – Matt Amend, Chairman of the Committee, advised that Badger Mining donated 3 deer stands, an anonymous donor provided 1 stand, and the Deer Committee purchased 3 additional stands. He also indicated there will be 10 hunters.

Village of Fairwater Compost – Rodney Symons, representing the Village of Fairwater, appeared and clarified questions relating to Fairwater's request to temporarily dispose of brush at the recycling center. Motion was made by Rich/Pat to allow the Village of Fairwater to dispose of brush at the recycling center at no cost until the end of 2024 as they attempt to secure a permanent location. Motion carried.

Recycling Center Brush Agreement – No action.

Kiwanis Park Warming Shed – Pat provided an update on the status of the warming shed repairs. It is hoped the project will be finished soon.

New Business:

Little Green Lake District Proposed Wake Ordinance – Motion by Rich/Clint to entertain a proposed ordinance prohibiting Wake Surfing on Little Green Lake. Motion carried.

Markesan Lion's Proposed Changes to Memorandum of Understanding – Following discussion on proposed changes, motion was made by Rich/Joseph to table the matter until October, and invite the Lion's to attend our committee meeting to discuss the matter, Motion carried.

Review Kiwanis Park Layout Plan – No action.

As there was no further business to come before the Committee, motion was made by Joseph/Clint to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
