Repairs to Library Shed –

Signage Entering the City –

Following discussion, a motion was made by Rich/Clint to authorize Pat to work with the Chamber to research designs and costs for new welcoming signage for placement at the edge of town. Motion carried.

Future Projects for 2025 –

Motion was made by Rich/Pat to create a subcommittee consisting of a representative from the Fire Department, the Chamber of Commerce, and the City to explore ways to improve Kiwanis Park for use not only for June Dairy Days, but also other community use. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rich/Pat to contact the Building Inspector to gather information regarding regulations and specifications needed for a new building at Soldier's & Sailor's Park. Motion carried. It was suggested that once this information is obtained we could work with our local lumber yard to draw up plans for review. It was also suggested Pat should reconnect with Modern Pole Rental to inquire what type of building they would suggest.
