March Public Property and Streets

Streets:

Several days of plowing for the month. Removal of snow piles from the City parking lot and historical society. The remaining snow at the historical society is unable to be moved as it is a frozen pile and hard on the equipment.

Removed as much snow as possible from storm sewer drains and curbs. Also moved snow along the curbs on St Joes and Catherine St trying to prevent freezing as water crosses the street
